Footnotes

BIG JEROME stalked three wide to the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch and prevailed after a long drive. GET STORMY took the lead before going a half, set the pace along the inside into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. PARC DES PRINCES (BRZ) raced in good position along the rail most of the way and held well for a share. BIG AL saved ground to the turn ad rallied mildly. SO IT GOES raced well back along the inside leaving the turn and rallied belatedly. PRIME DELIVERY raced well back while four wide after breaking slowly and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. BIG TOP steadied in traffic on the backstretch and raced evenly. PURE PULPIT failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN broke in the air and hit the side of the gate at the start then failed to menace. ALEXANDROS raced wide throughout and tired. NORTH COUNTRY made a four wide move on the turn and flattened out. NEMO LANDING was used up battling for the early lead.
