VERSE CHOIR away from the gate alertly, bothered KISSA MELISSA while guided over to the two path nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, stalked the pacesetter from the two path while attempting to keep something in reserve, went after the leader in earnest after being asked for a response heading into the stretch, forged to the lead, putting a head in front at the eighth pole, then held sway, despite drifting out noticeably during the final furlong. KISSA MELISSA was impeded by VERSE CHOIR when that rival crossed over in front around the nine-sixteenths pole, being forced to steady as a result, recovered from that incident to assume a good striking position while racing along the outside, bided her time during the run around the bend, angled outward in upper stretch, gained gradually on the drifting leader during the last eighth, but failed to get up. ROCK HALL HONEY bobbled at the break, set the pace towards the rail while being rated until the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing off. DIVA IN TRAINING raced three wide and tired. BOMBILLA off the inside, had the rider drop the whip in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole. SUZEE SUNRISE saved ground to no avail.
