**Footnotes**

GOLD D'ORO quickly in front, was rated on the lead from the two path, drew off a bit from the competition after being coaxed along around the far turn, entered the stretch with a comfortable advantage, still maintained it with a furlong to go, then dug in stubbornly under good handling to preserve the decision. DANCE PASS (IRE) unhurried during the early going under a good hold, was asked to pick it up racing three wide around the far turn, continued on with good energy to the wire to grab second. SENADA content to be reserved towards the back of the pack leaving the opening bend, was pushed outward by a very rank PALACE MISTRESS soon after entering the backstretch, recovered from that incident, remained on hold during the rest of way down the backstretch, was put to encouragement prior to making her move coming to the far turn, was bothered once more by PALACE MISTRESS, steadied while being pushed out to the five path, accelerated past that foe, continued to circle her way to contention from the outside, swung four wide into the lane, then sustaining the momentum, charged gamely down the center of the course, but had to settle for show honors. VEE between rivals, came home willingly. SONIC SOUND took the inside route, angled out coming to the quarter pole and rallied mildly. MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY well placed until the top of the stretch, had no rally. UPPER GULCH tracked from the rail and tired. PALACE MISTRESS very rank leaving the opening turn, swerved out to the three path early on the backstretch, impeding SENADA, rushed up to the front after being given free rein, began backing off nearing the far turn, was rank again, impeding and bothering SENADA a second time, was successfully maneuvered over to the two path and steadily tired thereafter.
