ADIOS NARDO tracked the pace from the two path well rated, briefly waited at the top of the lane in behind a trio, angled out after straightening away to the four path and commenced a rally, engaged the front with a furlong to go displaying a good kick to go on by in the final sixteenth under mostly hand urging with intermittent taps on the shoulder to win going away at the end. HARDROCKER broke out at the start and was corrected, was steadied early on as DAVE'S DREAM crossed over just into the first turn, sat well rated just off the pace three wide until the five-sixteenths when placed to a drive, took over command nearing the final furlong and inched away, was confronted through the latter portion of the drive, yielded the front inside the sixteenth marker while continuing on willingly for the place. GRIFFIN ROCK tracked inside well rated, came under urging at three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the lane, ran on with good energy down along the fence through the stretch for show honors. GREAT KAROO raced in midpack while two to three wide, came under encouragement swinging four to five wide at the head of the lane, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. THE KID N ME three wide under reserve in

midpack, came under coaxing to get involved at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home and bid mildly through the lane. EL CUADRO set the pace from just off the inside in the two path, was let out nearing the quarter pole when under intensified pressure, succumbed the front nearing the eighth pole and weakened thereafter. STREET CRUISE raced four wide in close range of the front, came under urging at the three-eighths pole and tired. SECTION A raced towards the rear in the two path, swung three wide for home and made no impact. NORTHERN HERO towards the rear three wide and between rivals part of the way, spun four wide for home while never involved. FIVE FREEDOMS allowed to settle at the rear four wide, swung five wide for home offering no response when called upon. DAVE'S DREAM attended the pace lightly urged for three-quarters and stopped.
