WILLY ELLIOT kicked away soon after the start, cut the pace, being rated along slightly more than two wide, was kept on hold as the two closest pursuers, those being SANTA ELF and JUMPINOFFTHEBRIDGE, failed to close the gap despite getting put to a drive during the later stages of the run around the bend, was pounced upon with suddenness by the runner upon entering the stretch and got called for a response, fought heads apart with that opponent from upper stretch under well past the eighth pole, edged away, driving. WARRIOR UP broke near the top, but was allowed to drop back, remained reserved from off the inside down the backstretch and a bit beyond that as well, picked up interest and unleashed a bold run from the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole to latch on to the winner as the pair headed into the stretch, was the inner member of a duel racing the stretch, got shaken off in the late stages and had to settle for the place. SANTA ELF chased the winner three wide, under a long hard drive that commenced from before the half mile pole, proved no match for the top twosome in the final stages. EVEN GOT QUIET four wide at the three-eighths pole, held on reasonably well to secure the last major check. THIRD KNIGHT carried in a bit at the break by MISTER WOOLMAN, took the inside route, had already felt the stick by the midway point on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. JUMPINOFFTHEEDGE was bumped at the start, chased the winner from off the inside, was sent over to the rail leaving the five-sixteenths marker and given his cue, cut the corner under a drive, made no headway. EL OH EL made contact with the rival breaking to the right side at the start, was strung out on the overland route for most of the way on the turn, gave way. MISTER WOOLMAN came in sharply taking THIRD KNIGHT along for a short ride, although avoiding any significant contact with that foe, saved ground to the quarter pole, drifted three wide into the stretch, and was essentially eased from that point to the wire.
