VIVI'S BOOK saved ground while unhurried for a half, rallied along the rail midway on the turn, steadied in traffic nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide to get clear, charged to the front leaving the furlong marker then held off the runner-up under steady urging. WILD AWAKE raced well back for a half, advanced between horses on the turn, swung out at the quarter pole and gained steadily but could not get up. CHORUS MUSIC raced up close between horses, rallied three wide on the turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. EXCLUSIVE SCHEME was outrun after breaking a bit slowly, closed the gap four wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. SAX IN THE CITY raced just off the pace along the inside and finished evenly. WHO IS LADY pressed in the two path and weakened leaving the turn. TUTTI VA BENE checked early, raced in hand for a half and faded on the turn. HIGH CRY chased three wide for a half and dropped back on the turn. TOORALLOORACOLLORA set the pace on the rail and gave way on the turn. CARMEN CAMACHO was outrun.
