JET SET CAT sat reserved in the opening stages, was taken outward upon reaching the second turn and squeezed into the three path at the midway point, closed the gap, was already urging entering the stretch, maintained the momentum after settling into upper stretch, wrested away the lead a couple of jumps before the finish line to prove best. MANACOR (IRE) swung four wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to garner the place. PATENT PENDING TOM raced from off the inside, was angled outward for better racing room in upper stretch and displayed a good kick down the center of the course to secure the show. UP ABOVE rushed three wide to grab the early advantage, was guided over to the inside after having done so, argued to maintain the advantage when the closest pursuer latch on coming to the end of the backstretch, remained under pressure from that opponent until mid lane, relinquished to fresher challenges soon afterwards. VERVEITUP prompted the pacesetter from the outside until the eighth pole and tired. COYOTE

CANYON cut the corner and flattened out. L. C. SLEEPY saved ground and faltered. MIGHTYLOVER four wide departing the three-eighths pole, was wider still entering the lane, never got involved. ALVITO forwardly placed outside until the quarter pole, folded. LOGICAL ORDER strung out three wide until the quarter pole, stopped.
