HARTS GAP raced with the pace and stayed on gamely to earn the place prize. ERASE was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely. SKY COVER set the pace and stayed on well inside in the stretch. MAGIC TALK broke awkwardly, was outrun early, raced inside and finished well in traffic along the inside. ARAB MISS stumbled at the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FERVENT WISH (GB) raced wide and posed no threat. GRAND NATALIE ROSE tired after a half mile. FEIJOADA was bumped at the start, chased the pace and tired. MISSY KIRI broke awkwardly, was bumped after the start, raced wide, drifted, bore out and tired.
