E Z PASSER raced along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive, gained steadily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, grabbed the lead in the final seventy yards and edged clear. CELEBRITY SIGHTING placed four wide at the three-eighths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, came home with good energy en route for the place. LIFE'S MEASURE underwent a three wide pursuit, got called upon entering the stretch and finished willingly to earn the show. JACKY JUICE tracked the front runners, waited briefly before set down to a hard drive at the quarter pole, failed to make headway. LADY OF THE FOREST stalked the pacesetter from the outside, made a successful challenge for the lead late on the turn, came under heavy pressure by upper stretch, dug in until the eighth pole and succumbed. TRIBECA lacked the needed response. LONG AND LEAN vied for the lead along the inside on the turn, faltered. REAL GLORY lunged at the break, raced well off the inside and was through after completing three-quarters.
