SKY BLAZER patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, bid in earnest approaching the quarter pole, hooked up in a stretch duel with the runner up, fought on nearly terms, before edging away under a vigorous hand during the last sixteenth. POINT OF ENTRY accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, made his move for command late on the far turn, was called upon with the top one in tow just off his flank entering the stretch, battled hard and only heads apart with SKY BLAZER as the pair made their way through the furlong grounds, and for a short distance beyond, got shaken off and had to settle for being clearly second best. FILM MAKING three wide around the second turn, was urged into the lane, but proved no match for the top twosome. ETERNAL RULER (IRE) sat well reserved taking the inside route during the initial stages, looked to ease outward late down the backstretch, but lacked the opportunity, gained it around the seven-sixteenths pole and slipped into the two path, remained within striking distance, got called upon in upper stretch and was out finished. CHEYENNE NATION was no factor. RAFFINATOR away a bit awkwardly, stumbled at the start, stayed within range tracking the pacesetter from the pocket, was through after completing three-quarters. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA had a wide journey and was outrun. MARQUET REBEL crawled on the front end and wilted once the pressure intensified.
