MR E PHILIP vied early on before conceding the front to prompt tracking from the two path, swung three to four wide for home placed to encouragement, collared the leader at the furlong marker, drew away kept busy to the end. TORMENT threw his head at the start and was off a beat slow as a result conceding about three lengths to the front, raced three wide towards the rear, swung five wide for home, moved into prominence nearing the eighth pole, kicked on belatedly to just garner the place honors. SIDE PARTY RALPH vied early on before shaking free to safely set the pace while off the inside, was confronted after straightening for home, got displaced on the front with a furlong remaining, fought on holding well for show honors. ALL ZIPPED UP raced three wide in midpack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home under a drive, moved into contention in the latter portions of the lane with a mild belated kick, had the rider pause when short of room nearing the finish in behind SIDE PARTY RALPH and TORMENT while garnering the last major share. HERE COMES DRZ tracked the pace saving ground throughout along the rail, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the lane bidding mildly to the wire while out kicked for major shares. UNREAL two to three wide just off the pace, swung four wide for home, remained in contention until the furlong marker before weakening in the lane. THE WILEY VET raced overland through the turn, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home and made no impact. MR. BEER GOGGLES brushed the gate at the start, raced towards the rear inside, swung three wide for home and never factored. TELL GRANT raced just off the inside towards the rear and was never involved.
