HARPSICHORD broke out at the start bumping lightly with JUST SAFE before being taken off that rival, hustled crossing to the rail, set a solid pace inside accompanied and pressed early on and briefly before shaking clear at the half mile pole, extended her margin through the far turn under very little encouragement until set down down at the head of the lane, went clear through the lane under mostly hand urging and was geared down just inside the final sixteenth a much the best winner. JUST SAFE bumped at the start when HARPSICHORD broke in, raced two to three wide through the turn, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, came under stick work approaching the quarter pole and shied in under the second right handed swat suddenly, impeding SIBERIAN WILDCAT forcing that rival to check as she was bounced off the rail, swung three wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the place honors while never threatening the top. FLY CAT away alertly, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung three wide for home, offered up a late kick to procure the show honors. SIBERIAN WILDCAT saved ground in midpack, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, got impeded when JUST SAFE shied in from off sided encouragement near the quarter pole, was forced to check and bounced lightly off the rail lost some momentum as a result, cut the corner into the lane bidding mildly for the last major share. LAFAMILIA leapt slightly at the break and was off a beat slow as a result, raced two to three wide towards the rear, swung five wide for home, passed tired foes through the lane. OVERLOUD raced four wide at the rear through the turn, cornered into the lane in the two path, made no impact. LINS BACK hustled from the gate, pressed the swift fractions briefly from the three path, got shaken off at the seven-sixteenths, remained prominent until the quarter pole and wilted. THREE ZIPS lost her footing at the start, chased three wide towards the rear and offered little. There was a Jockey's Objection by the rider of SIBERIAN WILDCAT against JUST SAFE alleging interference in the far turn, as a result JUST SAFE was disqualified from second and placed fourth before the result was declared official.
