SAINTS ALIVE came outward sharply at the break, was under a strong hold by the pilot by failed to get away in time before making solid contact with MARTINI MADNESS who in turn made equally solid contact with TOP YANK, settled near the inside, angled outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole and was put to a drive, closed in readily, was briefly between foes battling for the lead in the late stages, gained a slim advantage then dug in with good determination to preserve it. DON'T SAY NO off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch, closed ground willingly to loom a serious factor with about a sixteenth remaining, fought with vigor with the winner in the final seventy yards, but got held at bay. YIELD BOGEY rushed up with a good burst of speed approaching the half mile pole to contest the pace as the widest of three, had the inner member drop out of the dispute in short order, continued the fight one on one with BROWN INDIAN thereafter, but closer to the inside, held on well to the end for the show. BROWN INDIAN disputed the pace from between rivals during the initial stages of the run around the bend, moved closer to the rail once one of the combatants could no longer keep pace, remained a prominent factor before weakening in the last eighth. SUPERIORITY three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, was two paths wider by the top of the lane, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. CURVE BALL chased two wide and gave way. TIGER WILLIE darted over to the rail shortly after

the start, failed to menace off the subsequent ground-saving journey. TOP YANK was the second of two rivals affected by an incoming SAINTS ALIVE as the field was sent on its way, went to secure a narrow early advantage, got confronted prior to the opening split being recorded, argued with them for about a furlong, steadily backed away afterwards. MARTINI MADNESS bumped soundly from both sides at the start, raced three to four wide on the turn and was outrun.
