### Footnotes

EASTWOOD pressed the issue from the three path, ranged up to increase his presence coming to the quarter pole, latched on to the front runner and was put to encouragement, gained ground steadily during the ensuing furlong, forged onward, continuing to whittle down the leader's margin all the while, got herded out a couple of paths or so in the final seventy yards by the runner up, stayed on his best stride displaying good courage and got the job done right near the finish line. MOONLIGHT SONG got away alertly and after going onward for a short distance was placed along the two path, vied to maintain control from there, with the winner gradually increasing the pressure as the pair made their way around the bend, got called upon for the stretch, saw the margin dwindle down nevertheless, started to come out leaving the sixteenth pole, stubbornly ignored the pilot initially flashing then using the stick from the right side as potential corrective measures, and a result took the top one along for a short ride, got caught prior to the wire. DAWLY along the inside route and under a drive on the turn, proved no match. DEMON'S DEPUTY swung four wide into upper stretch with nothing to offer. TWO SEVENTEEN gave chase from the two path, was put to a drive by the three-eighths pole to no avail.
