SABELLINA broke slowly, was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn, drew clear and was ridden out to the finish. MISS BABA raced wide on both turns and stayed on gamely in the stretch. NURSE CULKIN was rated along early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. SCHEMATIC DESIGN raced close up inside, dropped back on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and came again outside. PRISCILLA'S FLAG was outrun along the inside early, altered course in the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. IRISH RAIL stumbled after the start, contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. GALLANT ANGEL was outrun early, raced three wide and lacked a rally. RED SNOONY raced inside and tired. STARS AND SPICE chased the pace from the outside and tired. FIDDLERS FANCY contested the pace along the inside and tired.
