WICKED DIVA under a firm hold, made a successful four bid for the front soon after entering the turn, then maintained a safe winning margin through the stretch drive, while being kept busy to the end. SIMMY tracked the front runners from the inside during the early stages, slipped outward soon during the run around the bend, within striking distance, proved no match for the top one after entering the stretch but finished well enough to be clear of the rest for the place. SWEETHEARTS KISS veered in sharply after the start, moved up along the rail to assume position midpack during the run down the backstretch, took the inside route until being taken outward at the five-sixteenths pole, was put to left handed encouragement, rallied mildly to best the rest. ROGUE'S JEWEL ducked in on the turn, rode the rail before swinging out at the quarter pole, outkicked mainly weak ones during the stretch run to earn a major share. KAFFIEND showed the way from the two path and tired after going five furlongs. LAYLABEN bumped at the start, gave way. VICARIOUS took the overland route and faltered. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE bumped at the start, was outrun. TEAM PLAN lacked a rally. FIDDLERS ZEPHYR had a wide journey and tired. ESSEX FERRY raced three wide and folded.
