**Footnotes**

FLYING SAPPHO well off the inside throughout, fanned five wide into the stretch, gained rapidly on the front runners, took over in deep stretch and kicked clear. HONORABLE TRUTH raced towards the two path, between rivals for a good portion of the way around the bend, angled three wide into upper stretch and finished willingly to secure second. KARAKORUM FUGITIVE had a good finish down the center of the course to take third. ACQUIRED CAT set lively splits from the inside, with GENTLE RIDE in close attendance from the outside, spurted away when let out in upper stretch, yielded while weakening in the late stages. PRIMAL BABY worked her way into the pocket nearing the end of the backstretch, contently tracked the pacesetter from there, was under encouragement taking the two path into the lane, came up empty for the stretch drive. ECONOMIC TSUNAMI saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, was placed in the five path at the head of the stretch, failed to reach a contending position. NICE STUFF cut the corner into the lane, made no bids. LONG GONE three wide, was through after completing a half. GENTLE RIDE pressed the leader in the two path, folded. CATREIGN saved ground while trailing throughout.
