Footnotes

UNBRIDLED FIRE was hustled away from the starting gate and settled into midpack, remained unhurried for the opening half but picked up the pace upon departing the backstretch, steadily advanced towards the front runners under his own power during the run around the bend, stayed on hold, caught behind a wall of rivals for a few strides prior to the quarter pole, entered the stretch, went onward a couple of more jumps before altering course to the outside, responded positively when given his cue and emerged from the furlong grounds the new leader, drew off the last eighth under good handling. INPUT off a beat slowly, lagged behind in the early going, started to pick up interest late on the second turn, got straightened away after turning for home and had a good finish down the center of the course to secure second. REFLECTING took the inside route, was idled along while remaining near the rail during the initial portion of the stretch run, angled outward for better racing room in mid lane, mustered up a mild response en route for the show. MAGNIFICENT MOON placed five wide at the three-sixteenths pole, came home with good belated energy to earn the last major check. LONGWOOD LANE got bumped at the start, underwent a three wide journey, rallied willingly but had to settle for minor spoils. CONSPIRACY was no factor. DISTORTED DREAM came inward, bumping with the nearest opponent at the break, was strung out three wide on the elbow chute and one path wider for most of the way around the full turn, weakened steadily after completing six furlongs. NATIVE WAVE tracked the pacesetter from the inside, left the pocket midway on the turn, issued a challenge for command coming to the quarter pole, continued the pursuit for an additional furlong then flattened out. ARTIST COLONY was steadied after breaking awkwardly, sat reserved for nearly three-quarters, was already under encouragement spinning four wide into the stretch, made no headway on the front runners. STREET BALLAD three wide early, was towards the inside for the stretch run, had no rally. DERVISH PRINCE chased three wide and gave way. SHIPMAKER showed the way from the inside until upper stretch and tired.
