Footnotes

BOZIQUE unhurried during the initial stages, picked up the pace and took away position from PURE AFLEET nearing the half mile pole, departed the backstretch three wide, ranged up and vied for command as the widest of three for slightly more than halfway around the bend, was sent over into the two path once MYSTIC RHYME had retreated enough, raced on even terms with a much more energetically-handled AGUALINDA the rest of the way to the quarter pole, turned for home holding a slim advantage and was set down, gradually added to the lead during the ensuing furlong, began to drift outward, all the while still increasing the margin, with the pilot futilely at first using then flashing the stick from the right side, lumbered across the wire well in the clear. AGUALINDA under a snug hold by the rider, motored her way to the front, was released from that grip on the reins once the winner arrived on the scene at the end of the backstretch, argued to maintain command with another pair parked to her outside from that point until approaching the five-sixteenths pole, continued the fight one on one with the winner from that station having been put to a drive, fell back a bit but stayed in the hunt for another furlong, remained comfortably ahead of the others at the end for the place. MYSTIC RHYME contested the pace from between the top two finishers from the crown of the turn to near the five-sixteenths pole, lost contact with each of them yet went on to best the rest. PURE AFLEET off the inside, made no headway on the front runners despite being urged along on the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch with no offering. D. FROST saved ground and faltered. MISSED A WILDCAT raced along the outside, got angled from two path into the fifth one making her way through the furlong grounds, came up empty after completing this maneuver.
