GROOMEDFORVICTORY reserved down the backstretch, unleashed a bold burst of speed from the three path prior to the half being completed, competed with STONELY THE LONELY for control, with the rider of each mount holding something back to the top of the lane, was given his cue spinning into the stretch and quickly put away his nemesis, drew off, kept busy to the end. QUIET POWER steadily raced into contention while taking the inside route, left the five-sixteenths marker and got angled outward until three wide by the head of the stretch, mustered up enough of a response to garner the place. JUNIOR OFFICER gave chase from the two path on the bend, was already under solid encouragement coming into the stretch and was in time along for the show. INDY TUNE hand urged from the two path, kept pace with the pacesetter for a half before giving way. STONELY THE LONELY was placed at a slight distance from off the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, argued to maintain command at first with INDY TUNE and then with the winner, was put to a drive entering the stretch, got displaced in short order and faltered.
