REGALLY APPEALING was hustled to the front, set the pace while between rivals, drew clear when set down for the drive and was ridden out to the wire. BELLE CLAIRE raced with the pace along the rail, could not handle the winner in the stretch but was clearly best of the others. REGENT GOLD raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SUGAR MISS was steadied along the rail entering the turn and raced greenly. DANZIG'S EDGE, outrun early, came wide approaching the stretch but had no rally. SKYE BLUSH chased the pace from the outside and tired badly.
