SECRET STATUS was rated along between rivals on the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn, came three wide for the drive, responded when roused and drew clear late under a drive. JOSTLE contested the pace from the outside, drew clear between calls in upper stretch, could not stay with the winner in the final furlong but continued on gamely to hold the place. FINDER'S FEE was outrun early on, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. C'EST L' AMOUR was rated along on the rail and had no rally. HEAVENS ABOVE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. CAT CAY raced four wide and tired. MARCH MAGIC chased the pace while three wide and tired after the opening three quarters.
