ALBERT THE GREAT quickly showed in front, set the pace while well away from the inner railing, turned back a bid from LIDO PALACE on the second turn, drew clear when roused and remained clear while drifting out slightly through the stretch, driving. LIDO PALACE (CHI) raced close up early while well in hand, put in a run along the inside on the second turn, could not get by the winner then dug in gamely and stayed on to hold the place. INCLUDE was rated along early, raced between rivals into the second turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. PERFECT CAT was rated along early, raced inside and had no response when roused. UNSHADED dropped back early, was hustled along inside and had no response. TRADITIONALLY prompted the pace from the outside and tired after the opening three quarters.
