SHARP HUMOR was bumped after the start, flashed good speed along the rail, set the pace, dug in gamely in the stretch and was clear under the line, driving. TOUGH SHIPMATE broke awkwardly, raced with the pace from the outside and dug in gamely to the finish. PARKHIMONBROADWAY broke slowly, raced very greenly, split rivals on the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. BOLD MR. WEST was bumped after the start, raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. RIVER SQUIRE was hustled from the gate, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. EIGHTY EIGHT KEYS raced wide throughout and tired. FLIP A COIN raced inside and tired. TELESPEEDY was outrun.
