BROKEN TREATY raced with the pace from the outside, dug in gamely in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. OPTIMIST GIRL (ARG) raced in hand along the inside, rallied into the stretch, angled out in deep stretch and finished gamely. JOYEUX RULER was rated along early, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. CLASSIC MARILYN set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. FORT CARILLON chased the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. MARIAS LOCKET raced between rivals and tired. CLASSIC EXAMPLE was outrun along the inside.
