SAL THE BARBER took the lead soon after the start, was rated through moderate fractions for six furlongs, shook loose in upper stretch and drew off under intermittent urging. PINCKNEY HILL was under a firm hold three wide, swung four wide at the quarter pole and closed late to gain the place. TAMBORIM chased the winner in hand, raced up close into midstretch and was nipped late for the place. YANKEE EMPIRE steadied along the inside on the first turn, raced up close along the rail and lacked a late response. FOREST BELL was under firm hold while trailing swung five wide and lacked a late response. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) chased three wide well in hand to the turn and faltered.
