**Footnotes**

DRIVEN BY SUCCESS argued the pace from the outside during the opening half while keeping something in reserve, took over after going a half, was set down as soon as he entered the stretch, then drew off during the stretch drive, while being kept to the task at hand. DR. W away in good order, was dragged off any potential speed duels soon after the start, fought against the bit, offering some resistance to the rating tactics being applied by the rider during the run down the backstretch, acted more kindly nearing the turn, sat perched three wide, was put to mild urging to keep pace with top pair up front, began his rally in earnest turning for home, couldn't match strides with the front runner during the stretch run, but continued on willingly to procure second. LEGAL CONSENT vied for the lead along the inside for a half before weakening. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER steadied after the start, raced along the outside and had no rally. LAW ENFORCEMENT dropped back early, raced four wide around the turn but failed to reach a contending position.
