MORNINGSIDEHEIGHTS firmly rated, loosely tracked the pacesetter from along the inside, contently rode the rail, still under the same firm hold, before availing of the ample opportunity to slip outward near the five-sixteenths pole, ranged up to a good striking position, was asked for run in upper stretch, fought her way to a narrow advantage upon reaching the eighth pole, then edged away during the final furlong, successfully rebuffering COUGAR CRUISE in the process. COUGAR CRUISE under a firm hold taking the inside route, bided her time during the run around the second turn, spurted through an opening along the rail at the head of the stretch, advanced forward, looming a serious threat with a furlong to go, took aim but wasn't good enough, having to settle for place honors. WISE CHOICE raced along the outside and displayed a mild rally. REFINERY FIRE three wide around both turns, lacked a kick. BEAUTIFUL PEAR broke well to establish early command, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead, laying down a soft pace, drifted out to the two path turning for home, being tested for the initial time, was outfinished during the stretch drive. G. A. EMPRESS rated stalking, tired.
