OVERDRIVEN bobbed at the break, was taken in hand off heels as J C'S PRIDE was guided over to the rail soon afterwards, was placed in two path nearing the turn, ranged up rapidly under light encouragement towards the leader, drew alongside just past the quarter pole, went by after an abbreviated duel, then drew away, flashed the whip right handed periodically during the last sixteenth. J C'S PRIDE was urged from the gate to outbreak the field, crossed over to the inside nearing the end of the backstretch, making things a bit dicey for both the eventual winner as well as TRUMPET MAN, saw a comfortable early advantage dwindle down to just a length heading into the stretch, was put to the test by the top one during the run through the furlong grounds, relinquished shortly before reaching the eighth pole, reacted slightly from each shot from the whip, finally ducking outward a couple of paths from the final left handed smack in deep stretch. BIG CREEK broke slowly, raced three wide around the turn and proved no match for the top twosome. TRUMPET MAN was steadied soon after the start as the runner up made his way over to the rail, had a ground-saving journey thereafter and failed to reach contention. ENRICO PALLAZZO chased between rivals from midway on the turn until the eighth pole, tired.
