ZOW disputed the pace from the two path, with another pair close behind to his outside, began to edge away approaching the quarter pole, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds holding his biggest advantage, remained well clear under hand encouragement, while being intermittently flashed the whip right handed. THE PRIZE FIGHTER was urged into a forward position, with the rider applying pressure with the stick on the right shoulder as motivation, gave chase from the three path during the run around the bend, had his momentum stalled, trying to lug inward from the three-sixteenths pole to almost near the sixteenth pole, settled into stride at that station after constant right handed pressure on the rein mixed in with some stick work from the left side, flashed belated interest cutting into the winner's margin at the end. QUIET FAVORITE was slow to settle into stride, saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for a response at the head of the stretch and rallied to grab the show. NO FLAWS vied for the lead along the rail, was urged on the turn to keep pace with the top one, remained forwardly placed until the eighth pole and weakened. PURE GRIT was grabbed hold after ducking inward a bit at the start, saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. OFFICERANDAFOOSE lunged at the break, raced four wide around the turn, gave way after a half. BOSTON REGATTA out hustled early, chased three wide and was outrun.
