OUT OF YOUR MIND underwent a three wide pursuit, was set down in upper stretch, engaged in a stretch long duel with the runner up and proved best at the end. PACI DI NOTTE was taken to the inside in time for the run around the bend, showed the way facing some resistance all the while, was let out in upper stretch as the stretch battle with the top one commenced, battled hard and gamely but had to settle for the place. TURN UP THE MUSIC tracked from the inside and finished willingly en route for the show. RAFFIE'S CHOICE chased from the outside and lacked the needed response. HARLAN'S POINT urged three wide from the five-sixteenths pole, had no kick. NYKID TIME TO JAZZ saved ground throughout. MASTER SPLASH off a beat slowly, was hustled into midpack, took the inside route until the quarter pole, failed to fire after being called upon. BOURBON BANDIT pressed the pacesetter from the outside for a half before backing away.
