### Footnotes

GOLDEN WEEKEND underwent a three wide pursuit, spun one path wider into the stretch, closed in on the front runners, drew alongside SAINTS ALIVE in deep stretch and displaying good courage went by for the decision. SAINTS ALIVE patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, moved up nearing the quarter pole to increase the pressure on the leader, responded well when set down at the head of the stretch, overhauled CAYO HUESO a short distance from the furlong grounds, dug in with good determination before relinquishing to the top one, having to settle for place honors. CAYO HUESO sat well placed being rated in the pocket, just behind the front runner, squeezed his way into the two path between rivals heading for the quarter pole, worked his way to a narrow lead during the upcoming eighth, got overtaken soon afterwards, weakened slightly during the final sixteenth. ART CURRENCY under a firm hold early, tracked PAUL'S LAW while saving ground, took advantage off clear sailing along the rail once CAYO HUESO was taken off it, was moving well enough to loom a threat momentarily with an eighth remaining, altered course outward once safely past the former pacesetter, and came home willingly

to secure the last major check. PAUL'S ACE left well and made the front under his own power, tucked along the inside in the vicinity of the half mile pole, continued to show the way around the bend, was let out once the closest pursuers increased the pressure, remained a forward factor for an additional furlong, got displaced and steadily weakened thereafter. SUMFUN three wide, was no factor. MOR CHANCES raced along the outside and had no rally. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB was never in contention. MIND BOGGLING four wide departing the backstretch, displayed brief foot.
