Footnotes

ST. JEAN stalked the leader from the two path down the backstretch, ranged up and bid from between rivals coming to the five-sixteenths marker, grabbed a narrow lead and was hand urged the rest of the way around the bend, entered the stretch with several others still in hot pursuit and was set down to stronger handling, arrived at the eighth pole with a clear advantage but with the runner up bearing down hard on the outside, held on well enough to stave that foe off. WORLD PREMIER three wide on the turn, commenced the stretch run one path wider, closed well but came up short. GRUNGE GIRL took the inside route for just over a half, was fanned five wide into upper stretch and came home belatedly to take the show. MARIA'S LUCK raced between rivals on the turn, was under a hard drive by upper stretch, failed to gain ground appreciably. AFRICAN JAZZ rode the rail under a firm hold, was forced to check at various points while stuck behind a tiring opponent from the quarter pole to the three-sixteenths pole. ASHCRAFT SILVER pressed the issue three wide on the turn, tired. JULIE'S INA FRENZY the pacesetter along the rail for the initial half, got overwhelmed late on the turn and faltered. TATOO ME underwent a four wide pursuit, had little left for the stretch run.
