FINDER'S FEE, never far back from the outside, swung five wide entering the stretch and finished resolutely from the outside to get the job done. DEED I DO contested the pace while four wide and battled gamely down to the wire. GILDED DIABLO showed in front from the start, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. CASE OF THE BLUES raced close up along the inside, responded when roused for the drive and finished gamely. INDEMNIFY contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. SHAWNEE COUNTRY contested the pace while three wide and faded in the stretch. MEGHAN'S JOY, far back early, came wide into the stretch and finished with some interest from the far outside. SHE'S KIPPEDED chased inside and tired in the stretch.
