NAUTICAL BUT NICE contested the pace while four wide, drew clear into the stretch then dug in and held on under a drive. ROSIE IS A LEADER was outrun early, rallied six wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. TRICK AGAIN contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. STORM PROSPECT was hustled along outside, raced five wide and lacked a rally. APPRO was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. SIERRA KITTY contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. RED BOOOM contested the pace while between rivals and tired. DOCTOR AMERICA raced inside and tired.
