DEAN'S LIST raced in hand outside, rallied three wide, dug in gamely while drifting out in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. CAPTIVE MELODY was rated along inside, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. ANXIETY contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. EMMA CARLY raced wide and lacked a rally. GRAND SEPTEMBER was outrun early, raced between rivals, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. AWESOME LOIS was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. RISKY AGENDA had no response when roused. UNDENIABLY SILVER had no rally. DOSH tired after a half mile. ODELAY contested the pace from the outside and tired. CENTENNIAL CAT was finished early. A claim against the winner by the rider of the second place finisher, alleging interference in the stretch, was not allowed.
