COALTOWN LEGEND was squeezed back at the break, after being bumped soundly between rivals, was given ample time to settle into stride, entered the turn placed in the two path, was asked for run angling three wide for the stretch drive, gained readily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, collared the front runners in deep stretch and kicked clear. WEE FREUDIAN placed in the two path for most of the way around the turn, stalked the ongoing pace dispute and finished willingly to take the place. CREA'S LAW bumped at the start, was urged from the three path into the stretch and was along in time for the show. FIRST DAY stumbled at the start, recovered and moved up along the rail to contest the pace, battled from there with another pair from the half mile pole until nearly the quarter pole, turned for home still hooked up head to head with ONE NOTE SAMBA, fought his way to a narrow lead with a sixteenth to go, but soon succumbed as fresher rivals arrived on the scene. ONE NOTE SAMBA came inward and got bumped between foes at the start, assumed a forward position soon afterwards, was three wide disputing the pace with two others for most of the way around the bend, turned for home with the slimmest of advantages, battled hard during the ensuing furlong before being shaken off, weakened steadily departing the sixteenth pole. GROUND FORCE was taken in hand at the start in time to avoid making contact with the nearest rival, raced along the outside and had no rally. KARAKORUM ON BLACK knocked sideways leaving the starting gate, was three wide around the turn, tired after completing a half then was vanned off the finish. ZONE BREAKER saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun. OUR BRAVE WARRIOR vied between opponents on the turn before backing away.
