FLAT OUT sat within range four wide, gradually closed the gap from the pacesetter under his own courage during the run around the bend, was asked for a response, spinning the widest of a tight-bunched quartet into the stretch, forged his way to a clear lead under strong encouragement during the ensuing furlong, drew off leaving the eighth pole under a vigorous hand ride to win decisively. HYMN BOOK accompanied the pacesetter three wide, made a bid from there between rivals nearing the quarter pole, proved no match for the top one, but held on well to secure second. RODMAN off a beat slowly, was put to mild hand urging and grabbed the lead soon after departing the chute, showed the way from the inside with the rider applying rating tactics, came under pressure for the initial time shortly after leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was set down entering the stretch, relinquished the lead soon afterwards and weakened into the show slot. CONVOCATION was rated in the two path just behind the front threesome until the quarter pole, was taken to the rail before commencing to rally in earnest, had no kick while drifting back to outside steadily down the lane. COLIZEO pressed the leader between opponents until upper stretch and tired. ICABAD CRANE saved ground until the quarter pole.
