BIG BLUE KITTEN underwent a three wide journey, moved up to issue a challenge for the front in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, kicked clear when put to strong handling by upper stretch, had the runner up drew alongside just past the sixteenth pole, dug in stubbornly under a drive to fend that rival off. QUICK RECOVERY three wide around both turns, sat within range throughout the opening six furlongs, responded positively when let out after settling into upper stretch, reached the top one's hind quarters to loom a threat with a sixteenth to go, continued to cut into the margin gradually, fell short. SOLVENT lagged behind until the quarter pole, picked up interest after departing the backstretch, raced four wide from three-eighths pole, came home willingly to grab the show. BRUCE ALLEY contently rode the pocket, left it after commencing the stretch run, split rivals at the three-sixteenths pole and rallied mildly en route for the last major award. PHILLY ACE under a snug early hold, was given some rein soon after entering the backstretch, split rivals at the three-guarters pole to apply some pressure on the pacesetter, remained a prominent factor until midstretch and gave way. MISSINGLISALEWIS saved ground to no avail. CITY TROOPER vied inside and faded after going six furlongs. FAVORITE HOUR between rivals on the far turn, tired.
