HUNGRY ISLAND sat reserved at the back of the pack around the opening turn and down the backstretch, was guided into the two path for the run around the far turn, began to pick up speed under some urging gearing up for the stretch run, was fanned five wide into upper stretch, kicked into gear immediately after being straightened away, charged down center of the course, overpowered the field to take over just past the eighth pole, and drew clear under good handling. MY REDBYRD bobbed after the start, moved up to take up position in midpack soon afterwards. entered and left the backstretch from the three path, bided time while well within striking distance on the far turn, responded well when asked for run approaching the top of the stretch, fought her way to a slim and brief lead nearing the end of the run through the furlong grounds, was powerless to match strides with the winner, but dug in under good courage to garner place honors. PARTING WORDS was released from a snug hold coming to the half mile pole, raced three wide around the second turn, spun one path wider into the stretch, came home with good energy while rallying for third. CELESTIAL KITTEN bided her time between and behind rivals approaching the quarter pole, got called upon after settling into upper stretch, altered course outward for optimal racing clearance midstretch and used a good late kick to secure the last major share of the purse. NAPLES BAY between rivals on the far turn, commenced to rally after entering the stretch, attempted to split rivals through a newly-created hole a short distance from the eighth pole only to have it shut down tight quickly, was taken in hand off a wall of rivals and altered course futilely for room thereafter, gained the needed clearance too late to resume her best. SKATING loosely prompted the leader from the outside and gave way. TRIUNE set the pace well rated along the inside, came under intense pressure in upper stretch and soon succumbed to it. MOUNT HOLIDAY tracked the front runners from the pocket and faltered.
