ROB 'N GIN quickly showed in front, soon found himself with a clear lead, set a strong pace while in hand and was ridden out to the finish. BOMFIM showed good speed while under wraps, was eased back along the inside on the backstretch, came wide for the drive, could not get to the winner in the stretch but stayed determinedly to outfinish WISED UP for the place. WISED UP, unhurried inside, saved ground and finished gamely along the rail. FORTITUDE, outrun early, was roused on the turn and offered a mild rally in the stretch. OPTIC NERVE, close up outside early, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch but had little left for the drive. DOC MARTIN, outrun early, came wide for the drive but had no rally. PREMIER KRISCHIEF had no response when roused. NOTORIETY bobbled leaving the gate, was rated outside and tired.
