Footnotes

COACH BUTTS patiently handled along the rail during the run down the backstretch, moved up on his courage to make it a four-way battle for the lead approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch together with YELT sharing the lead after shaking off the other pair of rivals, went head to head with that one until approaching the furlong grounds, left the eighth pole with a clear edge then held sway under strong encouragement. YELT pressed the leader three wide, emerged within a head of the lead after turning for home, matched strides with the top one until nearing the furlong marker, and held well to the wire to be second best. CALL TIGER set the pace while racing off the inside, steadily tired after entering the stretch. THE TRUFFLE MAN kept on hold four wide, launched his bid after going a half, flattened out. DEPUTYVILLE off to an awkward start, saved ground during the run around the bend, came up empty during the stretch drive. AKIN was outrun. KING'S BAY was never a factor.
