DR. D. F. C. raced in midpack under a good hold during the run down the backstretch, slipped off the inside midway on the far turn, advanced forward while still being kept on hold, entered the stretch three wide, was finally asked for a response nearing the furlong grounds, hooked up with the leader leaving the eighth pole, then bested that stubborn foe, getting up in the last stride. TERGESTI outsprinted rivals for command, continued to show the way on an open lead, setting honest fractions, dug in when pressure finally came approaching the quarter pole, was engaged by the eventual winner leaving furlong marker and yielded ground grudgingly, getting nipped right at the finish line. BENLAYLA chased the pacesetter throughout and weakened during the final furlong. LORCCAN went past tiring rivals in the lane. LEE STEWART was never a menace. FEROCIOUS WON rated off the leader while travelling three wide, came up empty in the stretch. MORNING PERKS gave way after going three quarters. QUICK AND EASY was always inside. WINAWAY was outrun.
