POSITIVE PROSPECT took control soon after leaving the starting gate, sailed along on the front during the run around the bend, left the furlong marker still maintaining her commanding advantage, then finished the final furlong under a vigorous hand ride. EIGHTYFIVE S saved ground until angling outward in upper stretch, futilely chased the winner from that point, had enough to hold on to the place. INDIAN DELIGHT saved ground throughout. DRESSED TO WIN raced wide on the turn, ducked back to the rail in midstretch, showed some late interest during the final eighth. HOPE STREET widest on the turn, had no rally. HIGH DRAW was no menace. FLYING SAPPHO underwent a three wide journey and was done after going a half. MY ANNA ROSE faded from the scene after racing a half.
