HIGHER INCENTIVE was well placed behind her entymate, surged to the front on the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and held off the runner-up under intermittent urging. AMBIDAXTROUS was in hand along the rail for a half, swung four wide between horses to get clear at the quarter pole, drifted out while rallying in upper stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. QUEEN OF PROTOCOL raced in the middle of the pack from outside, circled five wide at the quarter pole and finished evenly. MESA GIRL checked at the start and failed to threaten while saving ground. CATTY MADELINE stalked three wide for six furlongs, lodged a bid between horses on the turn and flattened out. TOKEN SPECIAL was taken in hand early, saved ground to the turn and lacked a late response. LOVE CO rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace inside for six furlongs and gave way.
