Footnotes

FELINEFELON under a good hold during the opening stages stalking the pacesetter, moved up steadily towards that rival leaving the half mile pole, with COACH GRAVY joining alongside on the outside soon afterwards, raced as a team with that foe when both surged by the early pacesetter, entered the lane clinging to narrowest of advantages, shook free in upper stretch, felt the runnerup's presence at the sixteenth pole but dug in with determination to preserve the decision. GIMMEAROUTINE raced off the inside within striking distance, rallied in earnest nearing the quarter pole, closed ground to loom boldly with an eighth to go, continued to cut into the leader's margin, but came up short. COACH GRAVY three wide, moved in tandem with the top one nearing the five-sixteenths pole to wrest command away from HEAD HEART HOOF, while attempting to keep something in reserve the entire time, was only a head shy of taking over turning for home, was put to encouragement, but had nothing left to sustain the bid. WADI SUKI swung three wide into the stretch but lacked the necessary stretch response. MORINE'S VICTORY took the inside route until the three-eighths pole, failed to reach a contending position. HEAD HEART HOOF set the early pace towards the inside, came under assault from a pair of rivals coming to the five-sixteenths pole and readily succumbed. CORVO trailed.
