Footnotes

CHROMOSPHERE unhurried between rivals on the turn, was asked to pick it up approaching the quarter pole, swung outward, settling into the six path at the head of the stretch, took off in earnest once asked for his best, gained readily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, then continuing on with good determination, poked a neck in front right before the wire to prove best. BISHOP OF NOLA vied along the inside with SMART SELECTION for the lead, raced as a team with that opponent for nearly six furlongs, began to edge away at that point, responded well when set down in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, continued on with good courage during the last eighth only to get caught right at the finish line. JUDGE WELL taken in hand at the start, sat reserved towards the back of the pack, launched a bold four wide sweep departing the half mile pole, circled past rivals to reach a good striking position, lost some ground on the leader after that one was let out a notch, then came on again during the final furlong to earn show honors. EL TUNE prominently placed three wide around both turns, was outfinished. MILLENNIUM JET outrun early, commenced his rally positioned along the extreme outside at the top of the lane and finished well down the outside of the course. WISHINGONADREAM lacked the needed bid. PATENT PENDING TOM was outrun. SMART SELECTION contested the pace from the outside for three-quarters and backed off. HOPEFUL BOY tracked the pace battle from the pocket, was put to a prolonged drive and folded.
