### Footnotes

FAR ISLE gained quick control, lay down soft fractions from the inside, well rated and well clear of the mild pressure being applied by the closest pursuers, sat chilly as that pair failed to significantly cut into the margin, despite being asked for some run, in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a quarter of a mile down the road, re established control during the ensuing furlong and held safe. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and rallied for the place. MY NAN NELL (IRE) contently tracked the pacesetter from the pocket with the rider applying a firm hold on the reins, was released from that grip late on the far turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch, got out finished. ONE SPRING STORM three wide both turns, tired. GRANDMA kept pace with the leader from the outside for three-quarters and gave way.
