### Footnotes

EMERALD BEECH sat well reserved towards the back for the pack for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest under some encouragement late on the second turn, fanned to be five wide at the head of the stretch, charged down the outside of the course, made up ground readily with each long stride, capped off her strong stretch kick by collaring the runner up at the finish line. PARAIIBA underwent a three wide journey, moved up to be second challenger to LA REINE LIONNE nearing the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when given her cue entering the stretch, fought her way to the front during the ensuing furlong, lengthened away to a comfortable advantage, saw it dwindle down as the top one rushed up from the outside and got nipped right on the money. FRIVOLOUS BUCK left the rail coming to the half mile pole, spun four wide to the top of the lane and rallied mildly to take the show. CRESCENDA patiently accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, took a shot at that opponent nearing the five-sixteenths pole, kept up a good pursuit for the lead until midstretch, steadily weakened thereafter. LA REINE LIONNE rated along the inside, was put to the test late during the run around the far turn, held her ground until the furlong marker before backing away. MUSICAL RAIN (IRE) raced along the outside and was outrun. PROTESTING faded off a ground-saving journey.
