Footnotes

MILLIONREASONSWHY assumed a forward position leaving the starting gate, left the backstretch three wide, took over the four path at midpoint when HOOK IT UP drifted onto the overland route, cruised up to join the front runners late on the turn, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, responded well when asked for run entering the stretch, was only a short distance behind the leader after completing the run through the furlong grounds, had the lead soon afterwards and edged away, driving. SAY A NOVENA was bumped between rivals at the start, went on to work her way to the front, was taken over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, crossing over to the inside just in front of GOOD LOOKING GIRL, argued for the lead with two others for a good portion of the run around the bend, turned for home and was called upon, yielded to the top one just past the eighth pole, but continued on with good determination to garner place honors. DANCING ANNA ducked inward, bumping with the runner up as a result, vied for the lead between rivals for nearly a half, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before weakening into the show slot. GOOD LOOKING GIRL came out and was bumped at the start, raced forwardly placed from the rail during the initial stages, began to fight the bit when taken in hand as the runner up was maneuvering over to the inside, became more unsettled after going on a little farther, was steadied after becoming rank in the vicinity of the half mile pole, began to act more professionally upon entering the turn, kept pace under light coaxing, angled out just past the quarter pole, was asked for run but failed to fire. DEFY GRAVITY three wide, disputed the pace on the turn, had the three path taken away by the top one late on the turn, was forced to go four wide into the lane and tired. HOOK IT UP took the overland route, was through after completing a half.
